

Master Plan for Zoo Leipzig

Since the year 2000 Zoo Leipzig has been implementing its 'Zoo of the future' master plan. Step by step, the entire zoo is being turned into six exciting theme worlds: Asia, Africa, South America, Founder's Garden, Pongoland and Gondwanaland. Modern and spacious enclosures are emerging that resemble the natural habitats of the animals living in them. The experience for zoo visitors is almost like being on safari.

Because all reconstruction measures cannot take place at the same time, the master plan was divided into three development phases. Development phases 1 and 2 have been successfully completed. Since 2012 the third and final redevelopment phase has been taking place step by step. The plan shown here highlights the new enclosures to be developed by 2027.

Master plan phase 3, construction areas 2021–2027:

Construction area IV: Tierra del Fuego and Terrarium

Construction area V: Asian archipelago with aviaries, Sulawesi, extension of Okapi forest and petting kraal (Pongoland)
